Goal

To support youth transitioning from shelter to independent living by building social networks, promoting lasting independence, and creating essential community connections necessary for a fulfilling life.

Ways We Support



- ❖ Collaborate with youth to develop a discharge plan upon leaving the shelter, ensuring necessary services are in place for successful housing
- ❖ Assist youth with setting up utilities and services at their new residence
- ❖ Provide resources and help with online applications for additional funding, grants, or subsidies
- ❖ Support youth in building community networks, including access to food bank programs, community meals, and activities
- ❖ Offer resources/support to help youth achieve their mental and physical health goals
- ❖ Offer resources/support to help youth achieve educational or employment goals
- ❖ Advocate for youth in matters related to landlords, medical or legal care, education, financial assistance, and employment
